Objectives and investment policy

The fund is actively managed. The fund is not managed in reference to a benchmark. The objective of the investment policy is to achieve sustainable capital growth. In order to achieve this, the fund invests up to 100% of its assets in equities, bonds, certificates, money market instruments and cash. In addition the fund may invest in derivatives for hedging and investment purposes, among others in order to hedge market risks. The fund will invest in different markets and instruments depending on the overall economic cycle and assessment of the fund management. Up to 20% may be invested into asset backed securities. When selecting

investments, environmental and social aspects and the principles of good corporate governance (ESG aspects) are taken into consideration alongside the financial performance. The selection of individual investments is at the discretion of the fund management. The currency of the fund is EUR. Returns and gains are not distributed but are reinvested in the fund. You may request the redemption of shares generally on a daily basis. The Company may, however, suspend or restrict the redemption if extraordinary circumstances appear to make this necessary, taking into account the interests of the investors.


