Objectives and investment policy

The fund is actively managed. The fund is not managed in reference to a benchmark. The objective of the investment policy is to achieve a positive investment performance. In order to achieve this, the fund invests globally in funds, predominantly in bond funds, near-money-market funds, currency funds and funds on bond and money market indices. Based on the assessment of the market situation, the net assets can also be fully invested in one of these fund categories. The fund may invest up to 60% in equity funds, mixed securities funds, and other funds such as commodity funds

or funds whose underlying is a financial index. The decision on which other funds to invest in takes into account the investment policy, risk spread, cost structure and quality of the fund management. The selection of individual investments is at the discretion of the fund management. When investing in other funds, the fund management takes into account the earnings and risk potential of the target fund. Returns and gains are not distributed but are reinvested in the fund. You may request the redemption of shares generally on a daily basis.


