
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Objectives and Investment Policy

- ▶ iShares SLI UCITS ETF (DE) (the "Fund") is a passively managed exchange traded fund (ETF) that aims to track the performance of the SLI (Net Total Return Index) as closely as possible. In this regard, it aims to replicate the benchmark (Index).
- ▶ The Index measures the performance of shares of publicly traded mid or high-capitalisation Swiss companies. It is a focused equity index with a high concentration of shares in the financial, healthcare and industrial sectors. It contains the 30 largest and most liquid shares on the Swiss equity market namely, all 20 Swiss Market Index (SMI) shares and the 10 biggest SMI Mid Index (SMIM) shares. The weighting of the individual shares included in the SLI is based on their free floatadjusted market capitalisation but is additionally limited by a capping model: the weighting of the 4 largest shares is limited to a maximum of 9% while the weighting of the other shares is restricted to a maximum of 4.5%. Market capitalisation is the share price of the company multiplied by the number of shares issued. Free floatadjusted market capitalisation means that only shares available to the public, rather than all of a company's issued shares, are used to calculate the Index, which is then capped. Liquid shares mean that they can easily be bought or sold in the market in normal market conditions.
- ▶ The Fund mostly invests in equities in order to achieve the investment objective.
- ▶ The proportion of assets in the Fund which matches the weighting of the Index (duplication percentage) is at least 95% of the Fund's assets.
- ▶ It is not the Investment Manager's intention to leverage the Fund. However, the Fund may generate minimal amounts of leverage from time to time, for example, if using financial derivative instruments (FDIs) for efficient portfolio management purposes.
- ▶ Recommendation: This Fund is suitable for medium to long term investment, though the Fund may also be suitable for shorter term exposure to the Index.
- ▶ The units in the Fund are distributing units. Income from the Fund's investments will be paid out at least once a year as a dividend.
- ▶ The Fund units are denominated in Swiss Francs.
- ► The units are listed on one or more Stock Exchange(s). Investors can buy or sell their units daily during business hours through an intermediary on such Stock Exchange(s).

Charges

The charges are used to pay the costs of running the Fund, including the costs of marketing and distributing it. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.

*Investors dealing on exchanges will pay fees charged by their stock brokers. Such charges are publicly available on the exchanges on which the units are listed and traded, or can be obtained from stock brokers. If investors deal in units directly with the Fund or the Management Company of the Fund, the entry charge is up to 2% and the exit charge is up to 1%.

*Authorised participants dealing directly with the Fund or the Management Company (as the case may be) will pay related transaction costs.

The ongoing charges figure is based on expenses for the twelve month period ending 31 December 2021. This figure may vary from year to year. It excludes portfolio trade-related costs, except costs paid to the custodian and any entry/exit charge paid to an underlying collective investment scheme (if any).


