### What is this product?

OnCapital SICAV is an undertaking for collective investment in transferable securities (UCITS) incorporated in the legal form of an investment company with variable capital (SICAV) under Part I of the Luxembourg 2010 Law on undertakings for collective

#### Term

The Product does not have a maturity date (the Product has been established for an indefinite period of time). The Manufacturer may terminate the Product early. The amount you will receive upon early termination may be less than the amount you invested.

The aim of the sub-fund is to invest at least 50% in stocks, equity ETFs, futures & options on equity indices as well as units of UCITS and/or UCIs which mainly invest in equity securities of companies traded in global capital markets and/or in equity securities of companies deriving a significant income portion in global equity markets. It may hold liquid assets as well as invest in bonds instruments, including fixed or floating rates, zero-coupons, government & treasury bonds, AND/OR convertible bonds, options & warrants as well as units of UCITS and/or UCIs that invest in bank deposits, money market instruments and transferable debt securities. Companies are selected via an analytical approach with a medium/long-term investment perspective. Investments may also be made via UCIs and UCITS. On regular basis techniques and financial derivative instruments are used to meet the investment objective as well as to hedge currency, market and interest rate risk. Investments are made in those currencies which best benefit the sub-fund's performance. It may, while observing its investment principles, buy and sell futures & options on financial instruments or conduct transactions for non-hedging purposes involving options on transferable securities. The sub-fund is actively managed and does not refer to any benchmark. A portfolio of Equity indices is disclosed for performance reporting purposes only. Sustainability risks are not systematically integrated on the basis of the investment strategy and the type of underlying investments.

The return of the fund depends primarily on equity market development and dividend payments.

All income received will be reinvested. The exchange rate risk of the share class currency is to a large extent hedged against the

currency of the fund.

# Intended retail investor

This fund applies to retail investors with a basic financial understanding, who can accept a possible loss on the investment amount. The fund is aimed at growing the investment value, while granting daily access to the capital under normal market conditions. # What are the risks and what could I get in return?

The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 4 years.

# What happens if UBS Fund Management (Luxembourg) S.A. is unable to pay out?

Furthermore, with respect to UBS Europe SE, Luxembourg Branch as depositary of the Fund, which is responsible for the safekeeping of the assets of the Fund (the "Depositary"), there is a potential default risk if the assets of the Fund held with the Depositary are lost. However, such default risk is limited as the Depositary is required by law and regulation to segregate its own assets from the assets of the Fund. The Depositary is liable to the Fund or to the investors of the Fund for the loss by the Depositary or one of its delegates of a financial instrument held in custody unless the Depositary is able to prove that the loss has arisen as a result of an external event beyond its reasonable control.

# What are the costs?
