## What is this product?

### TYPE OF PRODUCT

The product is a Sub-Fund of Quaero Capital Funds (Lux), an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) incorporated as a variable capital investment company (SICAV) under the laws of Luxembourg.

### TERM

The Sub-Fund is established for an unlimited duration. However if, for any reason, the net assets of the Sub-Fund or of any Class or Sub-Class fall below the equivalent of EUR 5,000,000, or if a change in the economic or political environment of the Sub-Fund, Class or Sub-Class may have material adverse consequences on the Sub-Fund, Class or Sub-Class's investments, or if an economic rationalisation so requires, the board may decide on a compulsory redemption of all Shares outstanding in the Sub-Fund, Class or Sub-Class on the basis of the Net Asset Value per Share (after taking account of current realisation prices of the investments as well as realisation expenses), calculated as of the day the decision becomes effective.

### OBJECTIVES

The Sub-Fund has a sustainable investment objective; it is to maximise total returns while contributing to decarbonisation by investing and taking an active role along the clean energy value chain.

The Sub-Fund is actively managed. The Sub-Fund uses the index MSCI World Index for performance comparison only. The Sub-Fund does not track the index and can deviate significantly or entirely from the index.

The Sub-Fund's assets will consist mainly of equities and equity related securities (such as depositary receipts) of companies whose primary business lies along the clean energy value chain, including (i) clean energy technology development and production including solar, wind, bioenergy, hydraulic, geothermal energy; (ii) renewable energy transmission and distribution; (iii) smart grid management; (iv) energy storage technologies including hydrogen and batteries; (v) carbon capture and renewable energy services; (vi) raw materials used in the clean energy value chain; (vii) and energy efficiency including energy efficient products, systems and processes. The Sub-Fund invests 90% of invested assets in companies that have a positive revenue exposure to the above identified green activities. Except the sectoral focus, the choice of investments will neither be limited by a geographical area nor in terms of currencies in which investments will be denominated.

However, depending on financial market conditions, a particular focus can be placed in a single country (or some countries) and/or in a single currency. It is not the intention of the investment manager to invest more than 20% of its net assets in emerging markets. However, in case of opportunities or changes in the clean energy market sector, the Sub-Fund may invest up to 50% of its net assets in emerging markets.

On an ancillary basis, the Sub-Fund may invest in any other type of eligible assets, such as money market instruments, undertakings for collective investment (UCIs), cash. However, the Sub-Fund cannot invest more than 10% of its net assets in UCIs.

For hedging and for investment purposes, the Sub-Fund may use all types of financial derivative instruments traded on a regulated market and/or over-the-counter. Nevertheless, in normal market conditions, the investment manager intends to use only currency derivatives.

If the investment manager considers this to be in the best interest of the shareholders, the Sub-Fund may also hold, on a temporary basis and for defensive purposes, up to 100% of its net assets in liquidities, such as cash deposits, money market UCIs and money market instruments.

This Class is cumulative. Dividend distributions are not planned.

### INTENDED RETAIL INVESTORS

The product is suitable for retail investors with limited knowledge of the underlying financial instruments and no financial industry experience. The product is compatible with investors who may bear capital losses and who do not need capital guarantee. The product is compatible with clients looking for growing their capital and who wish to hold their investment over 4 years.

FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A. is not making any payment to you in relation to this Sub-Fund and you would still be paid in case of a default from FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A..

The Sub-Fund's assets are held with Banque Pictet & Cie S.A. and are segregated from the assets of other Sub-Funds of the Fund. The assets of the Sub-Fund cannot be used to pay the debts of other Sub-Funds.

### Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. ## How long should I hold it and can I take my money out early?

### Recommended holding period (RHP): 4 years.

The RHP was chosen to provide a consistent return less dependent on market fluctuations.

A redemption order is executed at the redemption price ruling on a Business Day (a full business day on which banks are fully open in Luxembourg), the application for the redemption of shares must reach the Administration Agent (FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A.) before 4:00 p.m. (Luxembourg time) two (2) Business Days preceding the relevant Business Day.
