What is this product?

TYPE OF PRODUCT

The product is a Sub-Fund of Quaero Capital Funds (Lux), an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) incorporated as a variable capital investment company (SICAV) under the laws of Luxembourg.

TERM

The Sub-Fund is established for an unlimited duration. However if, for any reason, the net assets of the Sub-Fund or of any Class or Sub-Class fall below the equivalent of EUR 5,000,000, or if a change in the economic or political environment of the Sub-Fund, Class or Sub-Class may have material adverse consequences on the Sub-Fund, Class or Sub-Class's investments, or if an economic rationalisation so requires, the board may decide on a compulsory redemption of all Shares outstanding in the Sub-Fund, Class or Sub-Class on the basis of the Net Asset Value per Share (after taking account of current realisation prices of the investments as well as realisation expenses), calculated as of the day the decision becomes effective.

OBJECTIVES

The Sub-Fund promotes certain environmental and/or social characteristics. The Sub-Fund aims to recognise the inherent long term impact of the infrastructure sector by supporting only those companies which are industry-leading on environmental and social responsibility and stewardship or are on path of committed improvement, provided that they follow good governance practices.

The Sub-Fund is actively managed. The Sub-Fund uses the index S&P Global Infrastructure Hedged Net Total Return EUR for performance comparison only. The Sub-Fund does not track the index and can deviate significantly or entirely from the index.

The Sub-Fund intends to invest its assets in a portfolio comprised of:

- equity of companies that are involved in or have substantial exposure to global real estate assets, global infrastructure assets, forestry assets mostly located in North America, agricultural assets mostly in developed markets, precious metals and commodity related sectors;
- undertakings for collective investment offering an exposure to the above-mentioned sectors;
- equity-related securities (such as global depositary receipts, closed-end real estate investment trusts).

The Sub-Fund is authorised to invest on an ancillary basis in other eligible financial instruments. The Sub-Fund can also invest in financial derivative instruments, for currency hedging and/or for other purposes.

In order to achieve the above objective and to ensure the liquidity of the Sub-Fund, the Sub-Fund will hold cash and cash equivalents at all times. However, the Sub-Fund will not invest more than 10% of its net assets in undertakings for collective investment.

This Class is cumulative. Dividend distributions are not planned.

INTENDED RETAIL INVESTORS

The product is suitable for retail investors with limited knowledge of the underlying financial instruments and no financial industry experience. The product is compatible with investors who may bear capital losses and who do not need capital guarantee. The product is compatible with clients looking for growing their capital and who wish to hold their investment over 5 years.

The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years.

The Sub-Fund's assets are held with Banque Pictet & Cie S.A. and are segregated from the assets of other Sub-Funds of the Fund. The assets of the Sub-Fund cannot be used to pay the debts of other Sub-Funds.

What are the costs?

How long should I hold it and can I take my money out early?

Recommended holding period (RHP): 5 years.

The RHP was chosen to provide a consistent return less dependent on market fluctuations.

A redemption order is executed at the redemption price ruling on a Business Day (a full business day on which banks are fully open in Luxembourg), the application for the redemption of shares must reach the Administration Agent (FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A.) before 4:00 p.m. (Luxembourg time) two (2) Business Days preceding the relevant Business Day.
