Objectives & Investment Policy

The aim is for your investment to reflect the performance of the Short IBOXX® \in SOVEREIGNS EUROZONE TOTAL RETURN INDEX. The Index reflects the daily opposite performance of a reference index, the IBOXX® \in SOVEREIGNS EUROZONE TOTAL RETURN Index, plus a rate of interest. This means that the level of the Index should rise when the reference index falls and fall when the reference index rises on a daily basis. The interest rate added to the Index level is based on the rate at which banks in the Eurozone lend to each other overnight and a market rate for certain bond sale and repurchase (repo) transactions earned on the short positions.

The reference index reflects the performance of certain tradable debt (bonds), and is rebalanced and reviewed monthly according to a pre-set methodology. For bonds to be included in the Index

on a monthly rebalancing date, they must be denominated in Euro, issued by a Eurozone government and have a remaining time to maturity of at least one year. Amounts equivalent to interest payments on the bonds are reinvested in the reference index.

The Index and the reference index are sponsored by International Index Company Limited.

To achieve the aim, the Fund will buy bonds and/or invest in cash deposits and enter into financial contract(s) (derivative(s)) with Deutsche Bank relating to the bonds/deposits and the Index, in order to obtain the return on the Index.

The Fund does not intend to pay dividends.

You may redeem your investment on demand on a daily basis.

The Fund is intended for institutional investors who wish to take a very short term view on the reference index e.g. for day trading purposes.


